World-Class Degrees

We offer seven bachelor's degrees covering subjects such as Economics, Business, Politics, Data Science and Psychology. They are designed either by King's College London (Psychology) or the London School of Economics (all the others). The degrees are awarded by the University of London - to which LSE and KCL belong - and are recognised globally.

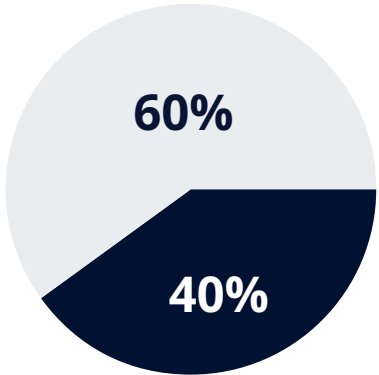

In the first year, students are based in Lisbon. Their Learning Centre is spread across two locations, both in the city centre. Meanwhile, the student residence is located in Benfica, a 20-minute metro ride from where the classes take place.

Student Support and Well-Being

Co-living Personal tutoring Counselling

At Forward College, we understand student wellbeing to be a sustainable state characterised by predominantly positive feelings, attitudes and relationships. Research shows that well-being is positively correlated with academic performances. Studying at Forward College will be challenging: our students will be pushed out of their comfort zones on a number of occasions as they transition from high school to university and learn autonomy, away from family in a new country, immersed in a multicultural student body. They will also be confronted with novel teaching approaches, potentially in a new language, and facing new types of collaboration such as working in teams or working on projects.

Friendship and community life

The first pillar of well-being is to develop meaningful relationships with their peers. First year students start the year with a two-week induction where they work together in small groups to learn the basics of teamwork and how to share feedback and manage differences. They will also enjoy fun activities such as a cooking contest, a surfing session, yoga on the beach, and more. Our small-group teaching and continuous teamwork also foster social connections. These relationships are deepened in our student homes where they cohabit.

Personal tutoring

Each month, all students meet their personal tutor who is generally one of the teaching staff. This is the opportunity to check in on their performance but also on their morale, social integration, and development needs.

Counselling

Short-term counselling is available during your first year at Forward College as you transition and adapt to the academic, personal and emotional challenges of entering university. Students may seek Forward College counselling services for additional support to help them manage the following concerns:

- Exam stress
- Managing anxiety
- Addressing study blocks and persistent procrastination
- Other well-being and emotional concerns

Where students are in need of alternative forms of therapeutic care, longer-term support or treatment for diagnosed mental health issues, Forward College can signpost students to the relevant healthcare services.

Learning Support Agreement (LSA)

Forward College is committed to creating an inclusive environment where all students can fully engage in university life. Students who have a current diagnosis or condition and are aware of the accommodations needed to support their success at Forward College will find that the LSA outlines approved educational or campus adjustments. These may include provisions for disabilities, neurodiversity, and long-term medical conditions or impairments, such as additional exam time for formative assessments or tailored transport arrangements for field trips.



Entrepreneurship Projects

Practical Intelligence Digital Skills

Personal growth, business acumen, and leadership develop mainly through guided practice and reflection, not lectures. That is why Forward College offers a range of additional Higher Education Certificates that supplement the academic training of our students. These modules have all been carefully designed with the support of 60+ top recruiters, entrepreneurs, and experts.

Forward College offers four Higher Education Certificates:

Certificate 1: Social Impact and Sustainability

Everything starts with an idea: reduce plastic consumption, promote climate-friendly behaviour, support people with disabilities, promote access to arts... Students will team up based on shared ideals and aspirations. Our faculty will take them through a step-by-step approach (design thinking) to help them deliver impact. Along the way, they will gain strong project management skills and acquire a set of core business techniques.

Certificate 2: Digital Innovation

This certificate is designed for students who wish to venture into creating a digital solution from scratch to explore a social or business opportunity they have identified. Students will team up and be guided through a step-by-step approach (agile methodology) towards impact.

Certificate 3: Research

Research is entrepreneurial as it requires courage, creativity, and rigor at the same time. You will work in a team in close collaboration with one of our Forward academic Fellows.

Certificate 4: Consulting with International Partner Organisations

Students will work as a consulting team to solve problems submitted by international organisations (NGO, corporate, start-up or intergovernmental organisation), partners of Forward College. Assignments will range from benchmarking, to exploring potential for a new product, communication strategy, co-design of a new solution or campaign... They will work with professionals and leverage their project management skills, business techniques and digital experience. Our faculty will guide them through consulting methods and techniques to deliver impact for the partner organisation.

Personal Development Certificates

Social Intelligence Emotional Intelligence

How to manage your stress or anxiety? How to decipher your emotions? How to connect with people and build trustful relationships? How to make wise decisions? How to engage others? How to cope with frustration and bounce back from failure?

All these challenges lie on the road to well-being, self-efficacy and positive leadership. Although the answers are personal, students can deepen their understanding, set their objectives and gradually develop the skills that will help them navigate these situations and grow their personality.

During these modules, students:

- Define their objectives for the module.
- Engage in discussions and practical activities during the weekly workshop in small groups.
- Train with peers throughout the week by adopting beneficial habits and practices.
- Debrief on their progress and outline next steps during the final session.

- Emotional skills: personal preferences, emotion management, resilience...

Your 360 Assessment and personal coaching

Every year, students participate in a 360 assessment that allows them to gain valuable insight from various people in their network including peers, teachers, friends, and colleagues. This assessment generates a 360 report allowing them to identify strengths and areas for development, facilitating the creation of an Individual Development Plan.

During two 45-minute one-on-one sessions, a coach assists students in interpreting the 360 assessment results and offers guidance on their development plan, asking them which skills they would like to focus on and how they can develop those skills.

- Year One:** Students and coaches focus on identifying strengths and areas for development from the initial 360 assessment, laying the foundation for growth and skill enhancement.
- Year Two:** Students participate in a second 360 assessment to track skills improvement and shift their focus towards honing skills that support their degree and career ambitions.
- Year Three:** A third 360 assessment helps the students and coaches identify the skills necessary to prepare for the transition to their next challenges post-graduation.
